Rules and Regulations

1. Word Limit

- Not more than 2000 words
- Excluding references, tables, figures, and annexures

2. Formatting Requirements

- Font: Times New Roman
- Font Size: 12
- Spacing: Double-spaced
- Alignment: Justified
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- File Format: PDF or Word Document (DOC/DOCX)

3. Originality

- The essay must be original, plagiarism-checked and AI detection score if any should be mentioned.
- Submissions with significant plagiarism will be disqualified.

4. Identification Details

- The essay file should not contain any personal identifiers.
- Submit a separate document containing:
 - Full Name
 - Designation / Course & Year
 - Institution / Department
 - Email ID
 - Mobile Number

5. References

- References should follow Vancouver style.
- They will not be included in the word count.

6. Submission
